RE: Prohibition of Parking on Streets during Snow Plowing

Enclosed please find a copy of Snow Parking regulations that were adopted for your development. The Public Works Department anticipates assuming responsibility for plowing sometime this winter after the streets are dedicated to the township.

Cars/motor vehicles will no longer be able to park on the listed streets when snow falls and the township Public Works Department needs to plow the streets. This is usually when the snow fall is four or more inches.

You must move all vehicles to your driveway or front yard. Cars left in the street will be towed. There will be no penalty if the car in your driveway protrudes across the sidewalk. You will need to move that car to the street once plowing is completed.

We feel by implementing these regulations it will help our Public Works Department do a more complete and safe job of plowing snow.

§ 232-16.2. Temporary parking prohibition for snowplowing and snow removal. [Added 6-8-2004 by Ord. No. 10-2004]

- A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway causing the township plows to be operated, an emergency shall exist and no vehicle shall be parked on the following streets or highways or portions thereof:

- B. The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased, until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
- C. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this section shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.
- D. The effectiveness of this section is contingent upon signs being erected as required by law.
- E. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of a provision of this section or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$50 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

§ 232-17. Violations and penalties. [Added 5-14-1996 by Ord. No. 10-1996]

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$500 for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
